Annual Executive Summary Reports

Year 1 February 1, 2016- February 1, 2017	Progress made in all focus areas: Personnel, Curriculum, Students, Physical Facility. Notable outcomes include new faculty member hired for 2015-2016 academic year, increase in size of graduate cohort, and purchase of endoscopy and stroboscopy equipment.
Year 2 February 1, 2017- February 1, 2018	Progress continues in all focus areas: Personnel, Curriculum, Students, Physical Facility. Notable outcomes include search for one tenure-track SLP faculty position and one tenure-track AUD faculty position, draft of proposal for new graduate curriculum underway, continued maintenance of student outcomes for employment and national exam pass rate, development of KILT program, and hands-on student training using endoscopy and stroboscopy equipment.
Year 3 February 1, 2018- February 1, 2019	Progress continues in all focus areas: Personnel, Curriculum, Students, Physical Facility. Notable outcomes included hiring and retention of one tenure-track assistant professor with the PhD in audiology; (a second tenure-track assistant professor with the PhD in developmental language and literacy was also hired but not retained beyond the 2018 semester); a proposal for a new graduate curriculum and conversion to the MS-SLP from the MA remains underway; continued maintenance of student outcomes for employment and national exam pass rate; transitioning the in-house KILT program to the Western Pennsylvania School for the Deaf at Edinboro University, which provides graduate students with rich, intensive clinical experiences with children who are deaf and hard of hearing; continued and hands-on student training using endoscopy and stroboscopy equipment; replacement of the camera and recording system in the Leader Center Speech and Hearing Clinic with a more flexible and better quality system; and securing of a contract to use an Electronic Medical Record system for graduate student training in documentation and related professional skills at the Leader Center Speech and Hearing Clinic.
