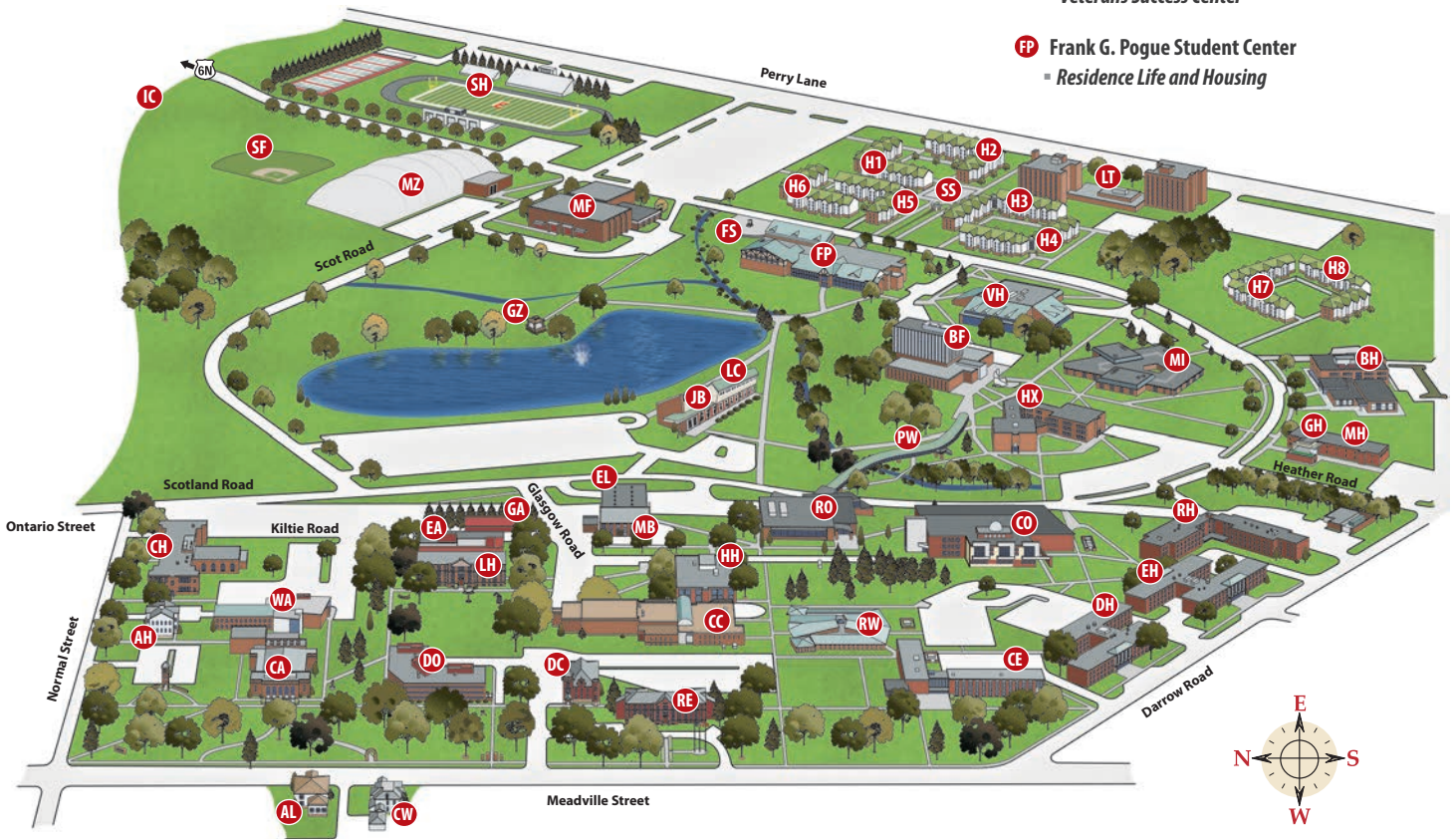

**A** **From Cleveland, Ohio, Area (approx. 2 hours)**  
Travel east on Interstate 90 to the Interstate 79 interchange. Proceed south on I-79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**B** **From Buffalo, New York, Area (approx. 2 hours)**  
Travel west on Interstate 90 to the Interstate 79 interchange. Proceed south on I-79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**C** **From Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Area (approx. 2 hours)**  
Travel north on Interstate 79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**D** **From New York, New York, Area (approx. 7 hours)**  
Travel west on Interstate 80 to Interstate 79. Proceed north on I-79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**E** **From Washington, D.C., Area (approx. 6 hours)**  
Travel west on Interstate 70 to Interstate 76 (Pa. Turnpike). Proceed west on the turnpike to Interstate 79. Go north on I-79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**F** **From Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Area (approx. 6.5 hours)**  
Travel west on Interstate 76 (Pa. Turnpike) to Interstate 79. Proceed north on I-79 to the Edinboro exit (#166).

**From Edinboro exit (#166)**

Go through the light at Walmart and proceed on Route 6N into the town of Edinboro.

At the first traffic light, turn right onto Rt. 99 south (which becomes Meadville Street). Proceed through town to the next traffic light (corner of campus). Turn left onto East Normal Street.

The Admissions Office is located in Academy Hall (building AH on the campus map), the first building on the right.

The Frank G. Pogue Student Center is building FP on the campus map.
