The installation is based on a permanent style scenario which includes a Document Camera, VCR/DVD player, a laptop connection and new Windows based PC with an Interactive Symposium display and a Gyro wireless mouse. Each device is connected to a new and very bright NEC projector which is mounted on the ceiling and controlled by a simple to use control panel that is mounted on a podium style instructors desk.
