PAYMENTS, LOANS, AND STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

Any past due balance and all fees for the specific summer session MUST BE PAID IN FULL by the end of the appropriate registration day, unless written authorization to enroll without payment has been given to the Bursar. Fees must be paid in full by check, money order, debit card MasterCard, Discover and/or proof of Financial Aid. All checks should be made payable to Edinboro University of Pennsylvania. Students can also choose to make payment by check (ACH), and credit card on the web with eBill.

Federal regulations require a student to be enrolled in at least 6 credits (half-time status) to be eligible for Direct Student loans, Direct Parent PLUS loans, or work study. As a result, refunds from loan proceeds will not be issued to the student until enrollment & attendance has been verified after the start of any Summer part of term that completes eligibility.. Students who change their enrollment affecting their full-time or part-time status may jeopardize their financial aid eligibility for the current and/or future terms.
