1. Complete the online graduate application (online.edinboro.edu)
2. Application Fee: \$30 (if not former EUP student); \$7 (if former EUP student)
3. Submit official transcripts verifying an earned baccalaureate and masters degree from an accredited institution.
4. Submit copy of Professional Certificate
5. Five years of satisfactory, professional, certificated experience
6. If you are interested in transferring credits from another degree you will need to complete a [Transfer Credit Form](#) and submit it to the address listed above.
