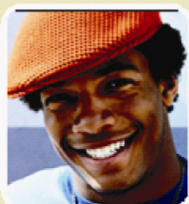
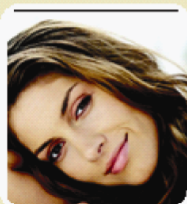

### Reader's Theatre Workshop Spring 2012

**May 21-25, 2012, 4:30-6:30 pm

This 10-hour workshop will involve the process of using scripts adapted for presentation in the Reader's Theatre format, both as a means to produce as well as to strengthen and develop the participant's reading skills. The class will meet to read and ultimately present a script as an activity to promote community and team building with no expectation of memorization. The instructor will serve as the director and coach for the presentation.
