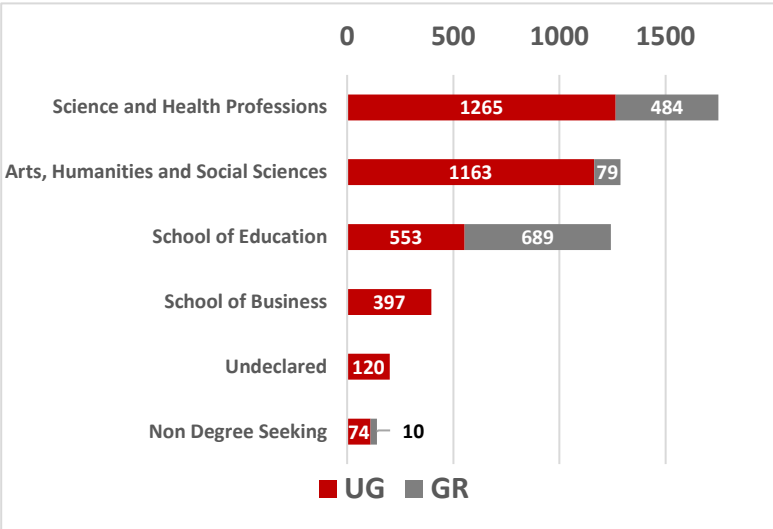
EDINBORO UNIVERSITY MISSION
