- Students interested in Mental Health Therapy with children and/or adults or related areas such as counseling or social work usually choose from PSYC365, 373, 375, 377, 387, & 388, and then take 440 and complete an internship as their capstone.

- Students interested in Neuroscience/Pre-Med/Health related careers usually choose from PSYC300, 332, 345, 350, 397, 400, & 410, and then take 425 & 497 as their capstones. They often minor or add a simultaneous degree in Biology.

- Students interested in Psychology and Law related careers usually choose from PSYC355, 360, 365, 385, & 390 and often minor in Criminal Justice or Pre-Law.

- Students interested in Schools/Art Therapy/ Business and many of careers will develop an individualized plan - *see your advisor*.
