INTENT

It is the intent of this policy to establish a procedure whereby professional employees of public and private institutions cooperating with Edinboro University of Pennsylvania in the training of students at cooperating institutions may be granted Adjunct Faculty status at Edinboro University of Pennsylvania. Such status is honorary and granted in recognition of service to Edinboro University of Pennsylvania.

POLICY

1. Professional Employees of public and private institutions cooperating with Edinboro University of Pennsylvania in the training of students at cooperating institutions shall be eligible for appointment as Adjunct Faculty. No person employed by Edinboro University of Pennsylvania shall be eligible for appointment to Adjunct Faculty Status.
2. Persons appointed as Adjunct Faculty are not employees of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, nor part of the bargaining unit certified as faculty under the current collective bargaining agreement between APSCUF and the State System of Higher Education; and accrue no rights or privileges under that agreement.

PROCEDURE

1. Recommendations for appointment of persons as Adjunct Faculty shall normally be made by the Department Chair to the Dean, through the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, to the President of the University.
2. The President of the University may appoint such persons as he approves to Adjunct Faculty status. Such appointment shall be for a term not to exceed one (1) year.
