**INTENT**

To prohibit the receipt of honoraria by certain employees. To prohibit the designation of such honoraria to the University or affiliated organizations in accordance with the State's Ethics Law (65 P.S. Sec. 402).

**POLICY**

No University employees who are defined as "public employees" by the State Ethics Law may receive honoraria for activities relating to the authority of their University position or employment.

In addition, they may not cause honoraria to be given directly to the University or affiliated organizations. (See attached Opinion of the State Ethics Commission and Vice Chancellor Richardson's July 12, 1993 memorandum for definitions and interpretation.)
