INTENT

The intent of this policy is to ensure the payment of student accounts due to the University.

POLICY

No student shall be enrolled, graduated or granted a transcript of his/her records until all charges have been paid in full. Exceptions to this policy require the approval of the President or the President's designee. The President will be informed of each decision, if designated authority is granted for this decision.

The University may utilize University internal billing procedures, the Office of the Attorney General of Pennsylvania or any other appropriate means to ensure the payment of delinquent student accounts.
