



## Network Account:

Make sure you know your network account information! Most EU computer systems require that you know your EU network username and password. You will need your network username and password to connect to the wired port in your room and to the wireless network. This information is on your acceptance letter.

### Steps to change/set your EU Network password:

Go to <http://www.edinboro.edu>

→ Click on **myEdinboro** portal

→ If you have not already done so click on the **Newly Admitted Students** button

→ For other password related services you can click on the **Forgot/Expired/Change Password** links

## Antivirus:

We recommend you have antivirus software on your computer before you arrive on campus.

- You can use any antivirus you wish. Make sure that the subscription is active and your definitions are up-to-date.
- Windows 8 has Defender built into the operating system so there is no need for additional antivirus software.
- Security Essentials antivirus software is available for free from Microsoft:

## WiFi Access:



In order to maintain the security of our networks, your device must be WPA2-Enterprise compatible to access our networks. All devices must support WPA2 Enterprise with PEAP. Please visit [www.edinboro.edu](http://www.edinboro.edu) keyword “wireless” for more information.

## Wireless Printers:



If you are bringing a wireless printer to campus remember to disable the wireless on the printer and use a usb cable to connect to it. Wireless printers are unable to attach to EU’s wireless network and they cause interference if left on. Turning off wireless can usually be done by pushing the button on the printer with the wifi symbol but you may need to consult your owner’s manual.

## Wireless Routers:



EU has the rights to the frequencies used for wireless networking. Ports that are found to have a wireless router attached to them will be deactivated and the user could risk loss of network privileges.

## Gaming:



If you have a game machine or streaming media device you can register it ahead of time. **The device must be used only on the wired network.** For more information go to the Edinboro home page and keyword search “gaming”.

## Peer-to-Peer File Sharing:



Remember to UNINSTALL any P2P software such as Frostwire, Limewire and Bit-torrent before connecting to the network at EU. We receive RIAA copywrite notices when copyrighted material is illegally shared from EU’s network. If you are found to be sharing copyrighted material, your internet connection could be disabled and litigation could be filed against you by the copyright holders such as the RIAA and MPAA.
